The quantities of yarn are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

MATERIALS

1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 - USA6) Knitting Needles.

3 [3:4:4:4] Buttons for V Neck Cardigan.

1 Pair of 3¼mm (UK10 - USA3) Knitting Needles for Hat.

4 [4:5:5:6] Buttons for Round Neck Cardigan.

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm (4in), over pattern. 22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

BLANKET

Using 4mm needles cast on 91 sts.

** 1st to 4th Row. Knit.

5th Row. Knit.

6th Row. P12, * k2, p11, rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep 5th and 6th rows 6 times

more. ** (12 Rows) (1 row)

From ** to ** sets patt.

Work 165 rows more in patt.

Cast off.

TOP AND BOTTOM EDGINGS (Both alike)

With rs facing, using 4mm needles pick up and knit 91 sts evenly along edge.

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. K1, pick up loop between

last and next st and work into the back of this loop (this will now be referred to as m1), * yfwd, k2tog, rep from * to last 2 sts, yfwd, m1, k2tog.

3rd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

4th Row. K1, m1, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, m1, k1.

5th Row. K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.

6th Row. P1, m1, * k1, p1, rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, m1, p1. 97 sts.

Cast off in rib.

SIDE EDGINGS (Both alike)

With rs facing, using 4mm needles pick up and knit 121 sts evenly along side edge.

Work as given for Top and Bottom Edgings. 127 sts.

TO MAKE UP

Join edgings at corners. Pin out blanket to the measurement given on front page. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

V NECK CARDIGAN BACK

Using 4mm needles cast on 39 [43:51:55:59:67] sts.

1st Row. K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.

2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to

end.

3rd and 4th Rows. As 1st and 2nd rows.

5th Row. K1, * yfwd, k2tog, rep from * to end.

6th Row. Knit to end, inc 0 [2:0:2:2:0] sts evenly across row.

39 [45:51:57:61:67] sts.

Proceed as follows:-

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures 8 [10:12:13:

14:18]cm, (3 [4:4½:5½:5½:7]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

33 [39:45:51:55:61] sts.

For 6th size only

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. [53] sts.

For all 6 sizes

Work 18 [22:28:30:32:30] rows dec 1 st at each end of 1st [1st:3rd:1st:

1st:1st] and every foll alt row.

15 [17:19:21:23:23] sts.

Cast off rem 15 [17:19:21:23:23] sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4mm needles cast on 18 [20:24:26:28:32] sts.
